### DAYS & TIMES

DEPARTURES EVERY 15 MINUTES, subject to availability

### ACCESS



ALLOW 10 TO 15 MINUTES ON FOOT to walk up to the esplanade and reach the museum from the car parks and public transport.

### RECEPTION & CLOAKROOM



HANDBAGS AND BACKPACKS MUST BE LEFT IN THE CLOAKROOM: individual lockers with code numbers available free of charge (32 x 47.5 x 35.5 cm; beyond these dimensions, suitcases and other personal belongings are not permitted); jackets can be kept on depending on the weather (outdoor areas).

REST ROOMS ON THE GROUND FLOOR; BABY-CHANGING FACILITIES.

STROLLERS: Strollers are not allowed on the historical tour; they may be left in the reception area, but without supervision and subject to availability.

BABY CARRIES available on request (subject to availability).

NO PETS allowed.
